## Investment Objective

Seeks to match the performance of an international portfolio of common stocks represented by the Morgan Stanley Capital International Europe, Australasia, and Far East Free Index ("EAFE® Free Index").

## Investment Strategy

The International Index Fund invests all of its assets in the International Index Master Investment Portfolio. The International Index Master Portfolio and the International Index Fund have substantially similar investment objectives. The International Index Master Investment Portfolio attempts to remain as fully invested as practicable in a pool of stocks and other equity securities that are found in the EAFE Free Index. Under normal operating conditions, the International Index Master Investment Portfolio seeks to invest at least 90% of its total assets in stocks that are represented in the EAFE Free Index.
