NHLI Training Program

NHLI's program is high quality, innovative and substantive. It looks to recruit participants who are diverse, talented and accomplished. It complements and builds upon other training programs by integrating personal growth with formal courses of study. NHLI has developed a four-week intensive leadership training program which spans nine months and is implemented in four different cities in the United States. This training includes sessions at the John F. Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University, and the Center for Creative Leadership. NHLI manages the thorough selection process.

Latinas Learning to Lead Summer Youth Institute

The main purpose of this program is to train the next generation of Latina leaders. The Institute combines leadership training with technical and practical experience in a one-week comprehensive program in Washington, D.C.

Latina Leadership Conferences

Five-city training conferences being supported by HR – Recruiting in Omaha, New York, Chicago, Atlanta and Albuquerque. State Farm zone leadership participates in each venue. Several women are trained through the Gallup Organization on the Seven Demands of Leadership. They also network with Latina elected officials, executives and other key community leaders.
